### 3 Overview

You can mount a combination of several Kramer products in a 19" 1U rack. These include half-19" 1U units, 1/4-19" 1U units and 1/8-19" 1U units. The examples in Table 1 illustrate how different products could be combined:

The **RK-1** does not have to be entirely full with mounted units. Use blank panels to fill the empty spaces (see Table 3).

### 3.1 Recommendations for Best Performance

We recommend that you:

- Have a Philips screwdriver and an Allen screwdriver available
- Disconnect the mains voltage and all cables connected to each machine that is being mounted in the rack adapter before proceeding with the installation
- Connect only good quality connection cables, thus avoiding interference, deterioration in signal quality due to poor matching, and elevated noise levels (often associated with low quality cables)
- Avoid interference from neighboring electrical appliances and position your rack adapter on the rack away from moisture, excessive sunlight and dust

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

## 4 Your Kramer RK-1 Rack Adapter

The example in Figure 1 illustrates the mounting of:

- One half-19" unit (for example, the Kramer **VM-9T**)
- One 1/4-19" 1U unit (for example, the Kramer MultiTOOLS® **104B**)
- Two 1/8-19" 1U units (for example, two Kramer MultiTOOLS® **PS-1DVI**)

## 5 Mounting on the Kramer RK-1 Rack Adapter

The **RK-1** underside includes a set of screw holes that are suitable for any combination of units to be mounted.

To mount the units on the **RK-1**, as illustrated in Figure 1, do the following:

1. Place the first unit on the rack (for example, the Kramer **VM-9T**).
2. Hold both the **VM-9T** and the **RK-1** with your hands and turn them upside down.




Figure 2: RK-1 Rack Adapter – Underside

3. Insert and the appropriate amount of screws through the holes on the **RK-1** that fit the holes on the underside of the **VM-9T**, using the M3x5 screws supplied with the unit (as illustrated in Figure 2).
4. Tighten the screws.
5. Rotate the **RK-1** horizontally with the unit connected.
6. Place the next unit (for example, the Kramer **PS-1DVI**) next to the unit that is already mounted.
7. Repeat steps 2 to 6 for each other unit.

## 5.1 Mounting Units that do not have Underside Screw Holes

Some Kramer machines do not have screw holes on the underside, which fit the holes on the **RK-1**. These machines (for example, the **VP-5xl**<sup>1</sup> or the **VA-50P**<sup>2</sup>) are connected via the screw holes on the sides of the **RK-1**.




Figure 3: Mounting a half-19" unit via Screws on the RK-1 Side Panel




Figure 4: Mounting a 6.5" Machine via Screws on the RK-1 Side Panel

To mount the units on the RK-1 as illustrated in Figure 3 and Figure 4 (**VP-5xl** and the **VA-50P** respectively), do the following:

1. Unscrew the two M3x6 screws from the side panel of the unit (for example, the Kramer **VP-5xl** or the **VA-50P**), which will be attached to the side panel of the **RK-1**.
2. Place the unit on the rack (for example, the Kramer **VP-5xl** or the **VA-50P**), adjacent to the inner side panel of the **RK-1**.
3. Insert the two M3x6 screws through the holes on the side panel of the **RK-1** that fit the holes on the side panel of the unit (as illustrated in Figure 3 and Figure 4).
4. Tighten the screws.

2 A 6.5" unit, see Table 2

## 5.2 Connecting a Blank Panel to the RK-1




Figure 5: RK-1 Rack Adapter – Connecting a Blank Panel

You can connect a blank panel<sup>1</sup> to the **RK-1** to cover any empty spaces, as the example in Figure 5 illustrates:

Labor and parts are warranted for seven years from the date of the first customer purchase.

### WHO IS PROTECTED?

Only the first purchase customer may enforce this warranty.

### WHAT IS COVERED AND WHAT IS NOT COVERED

Except as below, this warranty covers all defects in material or workmanship in this product. The following are not covered by the warranty:

1. Any product which is not distributed by Kramer, or which is not purchased from an authorized Kramer dealer. If you are uncertain as to whether a dealer is authorized, please contact Kramer at one of the agents listed in the Web site [www.kramerelectronics.com](http://www.kramerelectronics.com).
2. Any product, on which the serial number has been defaced, modified or removed, or on which the WARRANTY VOID IF TAMPERED sticker has been torn, reattached, removed or otherwise interfered with.
3. Damage, deterioration or malfunction resulting from:
  - i) Accident, misuse, abuse, neglect, fire, water, lightning or other acts of nature
  - ii) Product modification, or failure to follow instructions supplied with the product
  - iii) Repair or attempted repair by anyone not authorized by Kramer
  - iv) Any shipment of the product (claims must be presented to the carrier)
  - v) Removal or installation of the product
  - vi) Any other cause, which does not relate to a product defect
  - vii) Cartons, equipment enclosures, cables or accessories used in conjunction with the product
