



#### **Mounting Wall-M**


1. Feed the ethernet cable through the electrical box.



2. Mount the electrical box into the wall.



3. Connect the ethernet cable to the Wall-M.



4. Click off the front panel. Screw the Wall-M unit into the electrical box.
